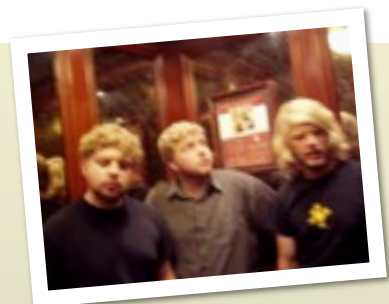
we're going to write, arrange, record, and post a new song to the website *every single week this year*, at Midnight each Sunday morning. April 28 marks our third
